

## POOL RULES

### **Failure to comply with any of the pool rules could result in suspension of privileges for 30 days.**

1. Warning, no life guard on duty. Swim at your own risk.
2. No person less than 16 years of age allowed in the pool area without adult supervision (An adult is considered a person of 21 years of age or older).
3. Absolutely NO dropping off of underage children unsupervised.
4. No food or drink on the pool deck or in the pool. Food and drinks are only allowed under the roofed pavilion areas or at the umbrella tables. You are responsible for cleaning up after yourself.
5. No glass containers on the pool deck or in the pool.
6. No alcoholic beverages on the pool deck or in the pool.
7. Smoking allowed in designated areas only.
8. Shower before entering pool. This is especially necessary for children returning from the play ground.
9. Proper bathing attire must be worn. Street clothes are not allowed in the pool.
10. All children under the age of **4 MUST** wear swimmers in **the adult and kiddies pools**. Parents will be held responsible if their child defecates in the pool. This includes the cost of cleaning and sanitizing the pools.
11. No diving in the pool.
12. No throwing or tossing of your children in the pool, off of the side of the pool or off of your person.
13. No running or rough-housing on the pool deck.
14. Small flotation devices (noodles, swim aids, etc.) are allowed in the pool under adult supervision at the discretion of the rec. center attendant.
15. Tossing of objects (soft balls, dive rings, etc.) is allowed in the pool under adult supervision at the discretion of the rec. center attendant.
16. No one is allowed in the pool or on the pool deck during thunder and/or lightening storms. The pool will be closed at the attendant's discretion.
17. No animals on the pool deck or in the pool.
18. Pool capacity is 89 people.
19. 6 guest maximum per household allowed.
20. Residents and guests who do not obey the rules will be asked to leave immediately.
21. Pass cards are to be used by the household for which the card was issued and are **NOT** to be lent out to other households or non residents. This includes allowing non Stagecoach residents access to the club house and weight room. Violation constitutes suspension of your privileges.
22. No private parties allowed at the pool.

**By order of State of Florida Department of Health under ( 64E-9.008 ), the Pasco County Health Department, and the Board of Directors under (Article IX (sec.4) & Article XII).**

**If your privileges have been suspended due to non payment of assessments or failure to comply with the rules and you are seen in the pool, weight room or club house areas you will be considered trespassing and will be asked to leave immediately. Failure to do so will result in the Sheriff's department being called in. You will not be allowed use of the facilities until your assessments have been paid in full or your given suspension period has been satisfied.**
